Jzk for the £1 donation for this month. This month we provided a copy of the Holy Qur'an in Braille for a 12 year old boy who has been blind since birth. He has a genetic condition which his siblings also have. We sometimes take for granted the blessings that Allah swt has given us and don't fully appreciate the gift of sight.

These children have never been able to see but are striving to read the Holy Qur'an using Braille. We hope they all experience the rewards and virtues of reading the Holy Qur'an.

-The Quran will intercede for us on the Day of Judgment: Prophet (SAW) said that: "Read the Quran, for verily it will come on the Day of Standing as an intercessor for its companions." (Muslim)

-Cleansing of Heart: When a Muslim recites Quran, it affects the heart and purifies it by cleaning it from all the impurities that stick on it. Allah Almighty says in Quran: "O mankind! There hath come to you an admonition from your Lord and a healing for the (diseases) in your hearts and for those who believe a Guidance and Mercy." (Quran, 10:57)

-Be from the best of the people: If you want to be the ones who are best in the eyes of Allah then teach Quran others


and learn it too. In hadith, our beloved Prophet (SAW) said: "The best of you are the ones who learn the Quran and teach it to others"(Bukhari)

- Quran will lead to Paradise: Quran recitation will lead all of them who recited it regularly to paradise. Our beloved Prophet (SAW) stated that: "The Quran is an intercessor, something given permission to intercede, and it is rightfully believed in. Whoever puts it in front of him, it will lead him to Paradise; whoever puts it behind him, it will steer him to the Hellfire."

This has been an act of Sadaqah Jariyah, which is a gift that not only benefits others in this life but also benefits us and our loved ones in the next. (Hadith of the Prophet ﷺ, narrated by Muslim) "When a person dies, all their deeds end except three: a continuing charity, beneficial knowledge and a child who prays for them. With this months project we aimed to have provided a continuing charity, as well as beneficial knowledge contained within the Holy Qur'an and we hope this young child will pray for all of us who have contributed. The Holy Qur'an that we donated comprises of six volumes in total. Below is an image of the six volumes.
