Thank you for this month's contribution towards our monthly projects. This month the project was not a charity project but one of kindness and one that will earn us rewards, as it counts as sadaqah jariyah.

This month we created more gift packs to distribute to reverts to Islam. We made another six packs, which comprised of luxury prayer mats, a tasbeeh and a book of duas and supplications with translations in English.

The reason we repeated the same project as last months was due to the gratitude we received for creating the first set of revert gift packs and the demand for help for reverts. Any type of support is received with gratitude so creating more gift packs seemed the perfect way to welcome reverts to Islam whilst showing kindness.

Our second project for August was donating toward the headstone for an unmarked grave. Two young girls lost their mother seven years ago and have an absent father. They are being raised by their elderly grandmother and have recently found their mother's grave for the first time since her death. We donated towards the cost of a headstone so that they can easily locate the grave when they visit the cemetery. For next month's project we want to support them in their education by buying resources for school such as uniform, shoes, school bags, as well as books, stationary, calculators etc. We will also be donating a food parcel for the children too. We endeavor to continue to support the elderly grandmother in raising these two girls and anyone wanting to contribute towards this, in addition to their monthly donation, can do so.
