This month was the 34th project that we have completed. It was an act of genuine and heartfelt kindness, as well as an act of charity towards others who are in need of a kind deed.

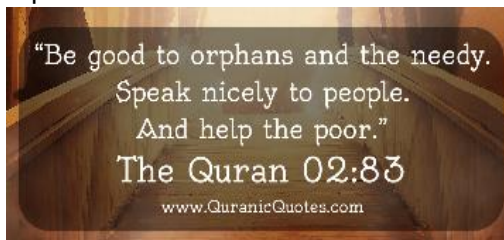
In view of the blessed month of Ramadan we provided iftari food to last one month to two orphaned sisters and their nan who is their guardian. We provided lots of staple foods, as well as fresh fruits, vegetables, cereals, drinks and snacks.

As well as iftaari food we also provided a gift for the two young sisters that will count as sadaqa jariah for all those who kindly donate every month towards our projects. We gifted the children with a Qur'an Majid in 30 separate juz for ease of reading, as well as a prayer mat to read their salah.

An update on a previous project: last year we contributed towards the gravestone of the mother of the two young girls who died several years ago. Her grave was unmarked and the girls had never been to visit the graveside, as they did not know where it was located.

The headstone and surround are now in place – see image on the bottom left. The girls can now visit the site of their mother's grave, as the headstone is clearly marked. During that previous project we also provided the girls with educational supplies and food. We promised to continue to support the children, which we have done; we endeavour to continue this support to fulfil our duty to take care of orphans.

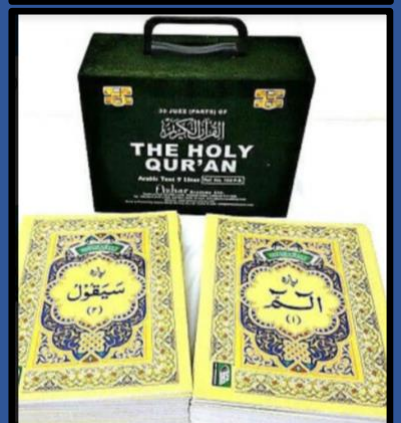
