BCM Pound Projects update

This month saw the 57th project being completed to help others. These projects commenced in Ramadan five years ago; this month was therefore the start of the sixth year of monthly projects to help others or to carry out act of kindness.

This month we donated towards a water well that will be supplied in either Uganda or Pakistan. The foundation that will supply the well is Al-Miskeen foundation; which has been running since April 2019 and is completely run by trustees and volunteers (no wages are paid) and helps the needy, homeless, widowers, elderly, orphans and people effected by man-made disasters, medical and emergency aid. The charity has a 100 % donation policy, as the admin fees and running costs are covered by trustee and charity members. Therefore, no charity funds are used towards the running of the charity. Al Miskeen foundation projects will have improved the living conditions of more than hundreds and thousands of people in countries like Pakistan and Uganda. Their vision is a better world, where all have access to living conditions that allow empowerment and development, today and long into the future. They believe that every human being has the right to an education, access to clean water and food and the means to support themselves, their family, and their community. They develop long-term development projects aimed at providing sustainable living for poor communities and survivors of natural disasters as well as providing emergency relief.

They fill many niches and give special emphasis to capacity building, economic empowerment, education and improving children's and women's health. Al-Miskeen foundation is also works on the ground delivering Medical Supplies and Food Aid to the communities that are in desperate need. Much of their work is installing, maintaining and fixing water pumps in Pakistan and Uganda. Water is an essential need, and many around the world have to travel long distances to get water for their families, Al-Miskeen have worked on many projects implementing water pumps in remote areas, providing communities with clean water for drinking as well as cleansing. Water pumps is a great way to give Sadagah Jariyah (continuous charity) and reap Allah swt blessing for as long as the well supplies water. The Sadagah can be for yourself, the whole ummah or loved ones who have left this world.
